Artspace exists to create unique, exciting venues which provide affordable spaces for artists to make, develop and showcase their work.

We offer a mix of artists' studios and space for exhibitions, filming, events, rehearsal and independent retail across our Bristol venues: The Island, Sparks Bristol, The Arts Mansion, The Vestibules, Broadmead XP.

Artspace was set up in 2006 by a group of creatives in Bristol who understood that art and culture needs places to flourish. Artspace began by revitalising meanwhile spaces - buildings that were changing use or in danger of being abandoned - to allow creativity to flourish in Bristol and North Somerset

Over time our remit has grown and in addition to providing affordable room for artists, we provide consultancy to professionals such as architects, planners and developers who are committed to regeneration focused on community need.

WHAT ARTSPACE TRUSTEES DO IN PRACTICE

Artspace trustees are responsible for ensuring that the organisation operates to standards set by the Charity Commission. The Board of Trustees take ultimate responsibility for the work that the organisation does, and the way in which it spends the money raised by the charity through income and donations. The Trustees are responsible for the strategic direction of the charity, agreeing plans and budgets, and holding the CEO to account for the delivery of the plans.

The role is voluntary and unpaid, but reasonable expenses are covered including access costs such as dependent / child care, communication support or other costs as agreed with the board.

Committments

:

We ask that you sign up for a 3 year term. Our full Board of Trustees meets virtually 4 times a year. Trustees also take it in turns to attend quarterly staff meetings, and our CEO and staff may also require occasional support.

You may be invited to represent Artspace at meetings, attend our project launches or key exhibitions and events such as our Open Days, or work alongside staff at events and receptions.


Currently the role of the Chair of Trustees rotates among the trustees quarterly. The Chair and the Treasurer support the CEO and Finance Officer with more frequent communications and support.

- Ensuring that Artspace has a clear vision, mission and strategic direction and focus
- Ensuring that Artspace complies with all legal and regulatory requirements
- Acting as guardians of our assets, both tangible and intangible, taking due care over their use and support
- Ensuring that Artspace governance and performance is of the highest possible standard
- To work in partnership with other trustees, the CEO, senior staff and our key partners and funders.
- Uphold our values putting inclusion, creativity and care at the centre of all we do
